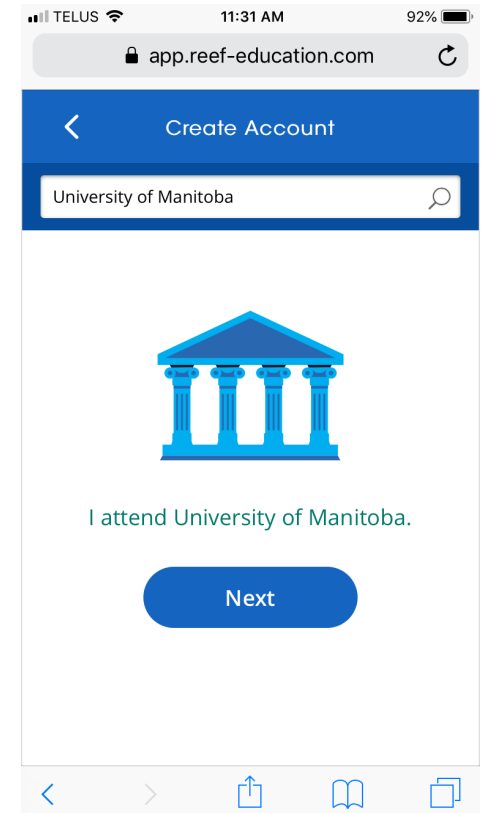


Introduction to iClicker polling


- Participate in iClicker polls using a smart phone (or tablet or laptop) or with an iclicker

- iclicker scores are integrated with UM Learn

Registering iClicker for this course

- Go to iclicker.com
- Go to Create an Account
 - you will be sent to reef sign-in page
- Make sure you select University of Manitoba for your institution



- Use your U of M email and 7-digit student id. Otherwise your grades won't synch with UM Learn.

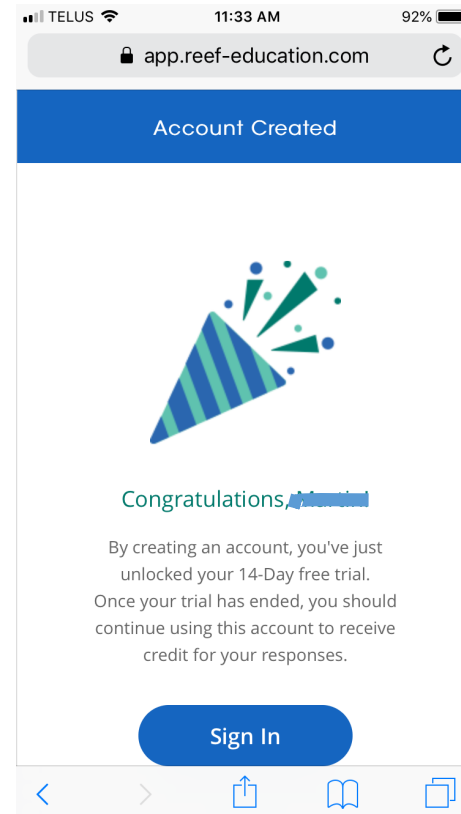

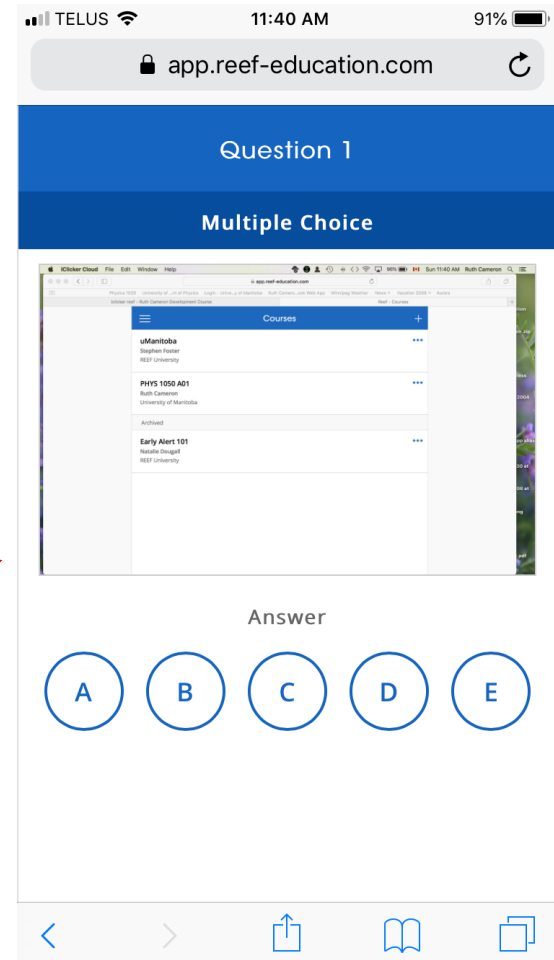

iClicker: Marking scheme

- Your iClicker answers will count for 5% of your final grade.
- Each class, if you answer 75% of the questions, you get 1 mark to indicate you are present.
- In addition, for every question you attempt, you get 1 mark.
- 1 further mark is awarded for every correct answer.

iClicker: Marking scheme

- Most lectures will have two or more questions.
- Scores may be renormalized to give all lectures the same weight.
- The best 30 lectures will be used for section A01 and A02.
- The best 20 lectures will be used for section A03.
- Therefore, the score in UM Learn gradebook should be considered approximate, and waivers for missed lectures will not be granted.
